**BACKGROUND:**

Segment One of the I-75 modernization project will involve rebuilding more than 2 miles of pavement between Coolidge Highway and South Boulevard. Included in this \$90 million investment is bridge replacement, drainage improvements, construction of an additional through-lane, and freeway modernization at the Square Lake Road interchange.
